International Student Certification of Finances

Although a decision on your application may be made without submitting the financial documentation, we are unable to issue the certificate of eligibility (Form I-20/DS-2019) without the financial documentation. This form must be presented to the American Consulate or embassy in your country in order to obtain an F-1/J-1 visa.
